denounce the following company (companies) for repeated harassing phone calls:

This company (these companies) call my telephone connection at any time of the day (in some cases after 10 p.m.) to promote their services or products. Although I have constantly told them to remove my phone number from their list, they call again, sometimes several times a week. Preferred hours are lunch time or in the evening, which means I have to get up to answer the phone, thus disrupting a deserved break from my work.

Not being a legal expert, I do not know if the Law allows this type of phone sales, but I base this complaint on the **Articles 5 and 12 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights:**

Article 5.
No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.

Article 12.
No one shall be subjected to arbitrary interference with his privacy, family, home or correspondence, nor to attacks upon his honour and reputation
Everyone has the right to the protection of the law against such interference or attacks.

I consider that these unwanted phone calls are "cruel" (I get extremely nervous) and an "arbitrary interference in my privacy, my family and my home."

I request this court to take appropriate action against the above mentioned company (companies) to stop harassing me with phone calls.
